

KCIK Award - how to take part

1. **Bronze and Silver Award.** An author of a Master (Bronze) or PhD (Silver) thesis on quantum information defended in Poland in 2020 is eligible to take part in the competition. The set of documents (all in pdf format) consisting of:

- a) file with the thesis,
- b) copies of all the referee reports,
- c) copy of a formal document certifying that the thesis has been defended,

shall be send by the candidate or his/her supervisor before

January 31, 2021 to the email address: kcikaward@ug.edu.pl

2. In 2021 the Awards conferred for the year 2020 are:

3000 PLN (Bronze) and 5000 PLN (Silver).

3. **Golden Award.** Any scientist worldwide is eligible to participate. The Golden KCIK Award is conferred for solving one of the problems on quantum information listed at the [KCIK webpage](https://kcik.ug.edu.pl/post.php?id=1981) (<https://kcik.ug.edu.pl/post.php?id=1981>). To participate, an author should send before **January 31, 2021**, to the email address kcikaward@ug.edu.pl

- a) a single page (pdf) summarizing the solution,
- b) a link to an [arXiv preprint](#) posted in 2020, in which a solution of the problem is provided.

4. In 2021 the Award conferred for the year 2020 is 2020 EUR. Up to two awards can be given.
